

Welcome to our June edition of Headlines. First of all, thank you for all your contributions to the Unicef Nepal Earthquake Appeal. We have raised a total of £1,486 so far. Our target is £2,000 so if you are able to send in any more, we'd be delighted. Congratulations to the choir and Vox for their inspirational performance in aid of the appeal.

June's 'value' is **ENTHUSIASM**. How wonderful it is to see the children enthusiastically practising their skipping skills. We have recently appointed a qualified teacher with **specialist PE** expertise, Mitchell Browning, to lead PE from September 2015. Charlie McNamara, our female sports coach, will continue to work on a part-time basis. Some important news about **After School Activity Clubs**: these will be run directly by the school from September 2015. Our aim is to offer club places for at least 200 pupils every week. Clubs will provide a wide range of high quality extra-curricular opportunities for pupils, where children learn new skills leading to increased confidence and enhanced well-being. Clubs will be engaging, well-planned and above all, fun! A range of sports clubs will be delivered by our specialist PE teacher and sports coach. Parents, carers and support staff have been invited to apply to lead other activities. Prior experience and expertise must be demonstrated before potential leaders are appointed in order to ensure clubs demonstrate best practise at all times. We have had a very positive response so far and would welcome any further ideas. You will be informed of which clubs are on offer and how to sign up before the end of the summer term, in preparation for the new school year.

If you know that your family will be moving out of the area this summer and that your children will no longer need a place at Coldfall come September, it would be very helpful if you could let us know as soon as possible. Thank you.

The children have enjoyed an exciting **INTERNATIONAL DAY** today, transforming their classroom into a country, making lots of interesting discoveries, making passports, visiting another 'country' and going on a simulated flight! I'm sure they will eagerly tell you all about it!

Thank you to the Friends of Coldfall for organising last week's Fashion Show. Some of our gorgeous teaching staff were models and a fun evening was had by all, as well as raising almost £500 for the school.
